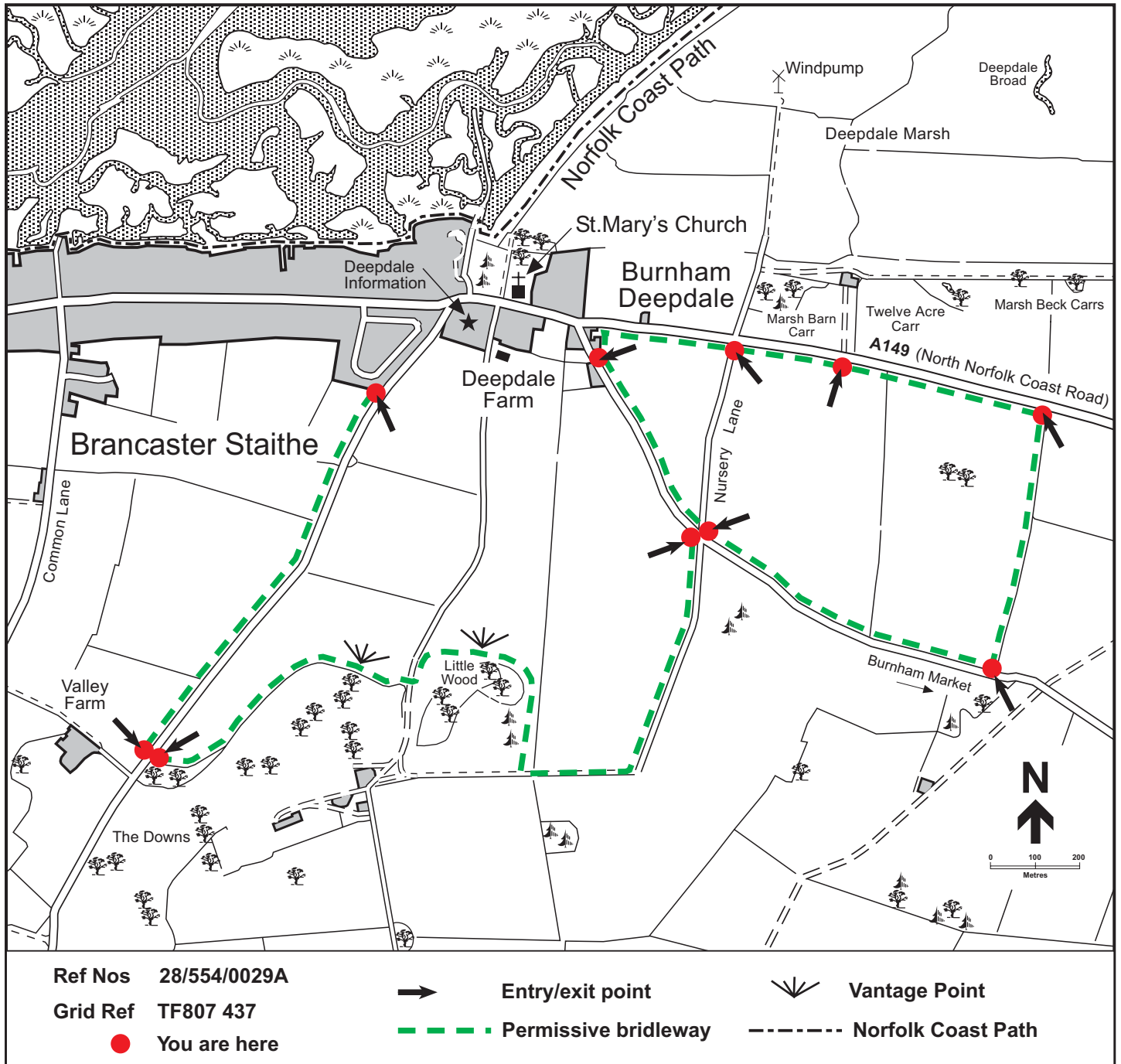


# CONSERVATION WALKS

This network of permissive bridleways provides safe, offroad circular routes to walkers, cyclists and horseriders around Burnham Deepdale following grass margins alongside field boundaries. Fine, panoramic views of the coast can be enjoyed along the way. The margins also provide a habitat for wildlife and help to protect the hedgerows, which are managed to enhance the landscape and further benefit wildlife on this arable farm.



This access has been provided under the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs' farm conservation schemes, which help farmers and land managers protect and improve the countryside, its wildlife and history. It is permissive access and no new rights of way are being created. Existing rights of way are not affected. Please follow the Country Code and observe any other requirements shown above. Do not disturb wildlife, livestock or other visitors and in particular keep dogs under control. This is working farmland so please take care; people using this site do so at their own risk.
