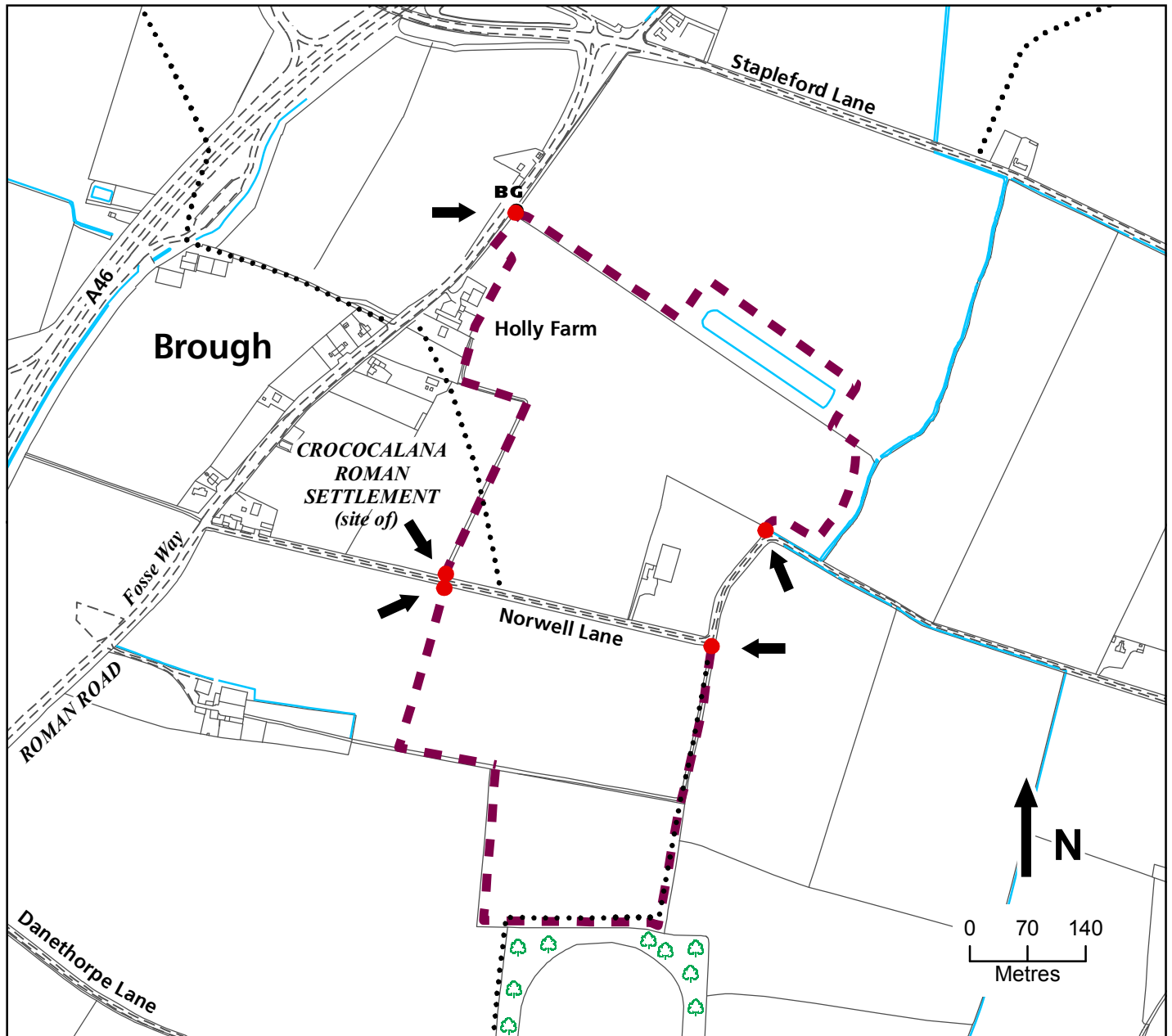


PERMISSIVE ACCESS

A new permissive bridleway at Holly farm provides opportunities for the public to enjoy the countryside around Brough. The 2.5 kilometre circular bridleway will take horse riders and walkers past fields which have been reverted to grassland to protect parts of the Roman town of Crococalana and other nationally important archaeology along the Fosse Way. Walkers & riders are advised to take care when crossing or riding along the short section of Norwell Lane. Please keep all dogs on leads.
