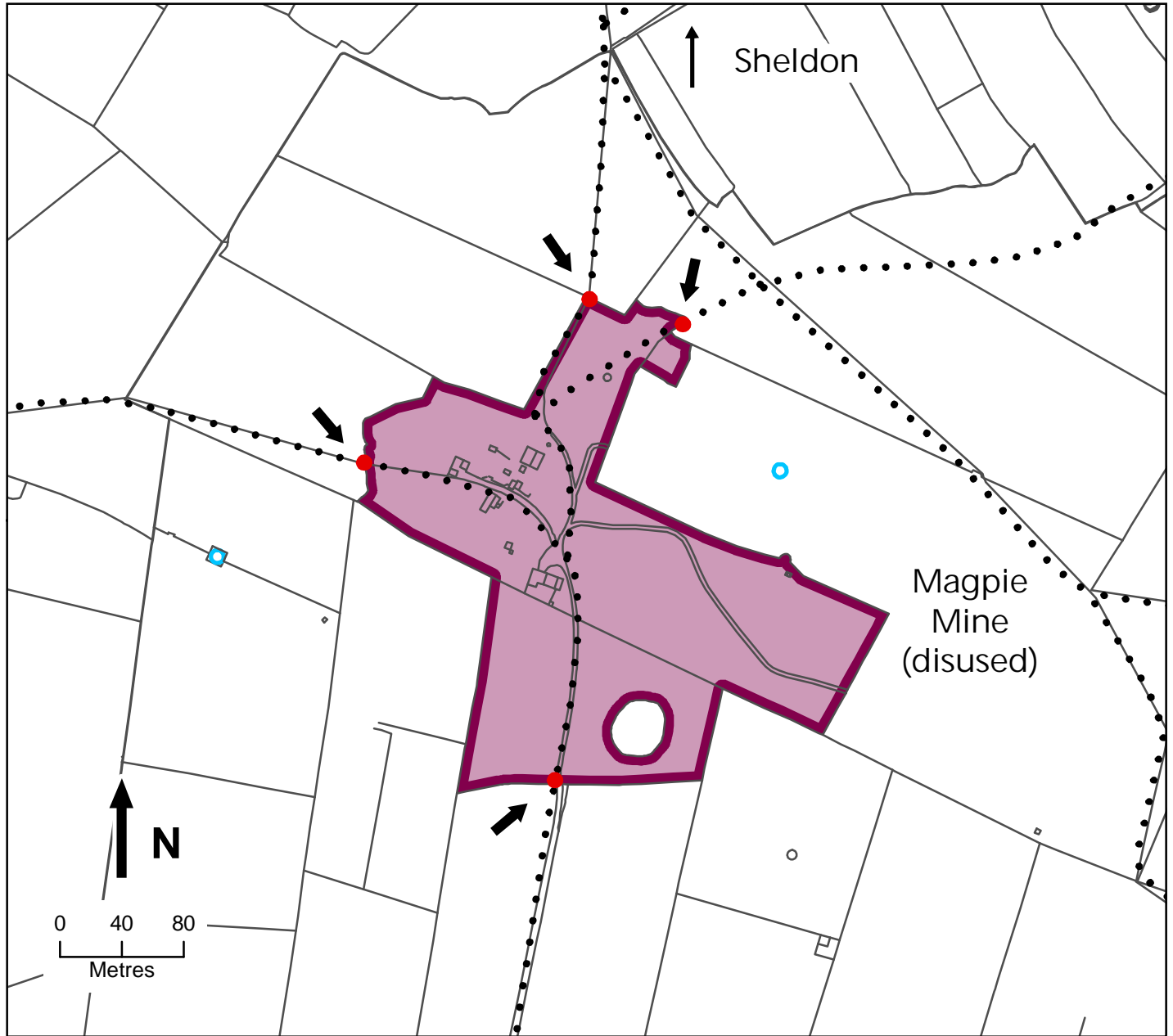


PERMISSIVE ACCESS

The land shown on the map is permissive open access for enjoyment by the general public. Magpie Mine is a Scheduled Ancient Monument and rare survival of the once thriving Peak District lead mining industry. The grassland is of botanical importance for its range of specialised plants adapted to high concentrations of lead in the spoil hillocks and is grazed sensitively to protect both the wildflowers and historic remains. Feel free to explore this unique site, but please be mindful of your safety and respect the Mine by leaving features in situ for all to enjoy.
